- AN ACT relating to prerequisites to issuing a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin to Dr. Jose Q. Tolentino, Dr. Manuel S. Lina and Dr. Constancia Lina of the Philippines.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Dr. Jose Q. Tolentino of the Philippines, having successfully passed the written examination required by the Wisconsin State Board of Medical Examiners for a license to practice medicine and surgery in this state and having completed all other necessary requirements excepting those relating to citizenship specified by section 147.15 (1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the provisions of section 147.15 (1) requiring a declaration of intention to become a United States citizen are suspended until such time as

an immigrant visa number is allocated to Dr. Tolentino and he may apply for adjustment of his immigrant status to that of United States citizen. Said provisions of s. 147.15 (1) are also suspended so that Drs. Manuel S. and Constancia Lina of the Philippines shall be considered for examination and licensure by the medical examining board without being required to file such declarations of intent.
