CHAPTER 129, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT relating to prerequisites to issuing a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin to Dr. Shapoor Ansari of Iran.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Dr. Shapoor Ansari of Iran, having been licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Maine and having completed all other necessary requirements for a Wisconsin license to practice medicine and surgery excepting those related to citizenship specified by section 147.15 (1) of the Wisconsin statutes, the provisions of section 147.15 (1) requiring a declaration of intention to become a United States citizen are suspended until such time as an immigrant visa number is allocated to Dr. Ansari and he may apply for adjustment of his immigrant status to that of United States citizen.

SECTION 2. If chapter , laws of 1969 (Senate Bill 353), becomes effective prior to the effective date of this act, then statutory references herein shall read "s. 448.03 (1)" instead of "147.15 (1)". Approved July 29, 1969.
