CHAPTER 13, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT granting to the county board of Vernon county, Wisconsin, and the town boards of the towns of Stark and Whitestown, Vernon county, Wisconsin, the right to abandon certain roads in connection with the La Farge Reservoir Federal Flood Control Project.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The county board of Vernon county, Wisconsin, and the town boards of the towns of Stark and Whitestown, Vernon county, Wisconsin, are authorized and empowered without any other act or compliance with any other provision or requirement of the laws of this state, including provisions for initial action normally to be taken by resident landowners, to vacate and abandon those county and town roads which are presently situated so as to interfere with the La Farge Reservoir Federal Flood Control Project, as set out in House Document 557, 87th Congress, 2d Session. The county board of Vernon county, Wisconsin, and the town boards of the towns of Stark and Whitestown are further authorized to enter into contracts with the United States government through the secretary of the army and his designated representatives to provide for the relocation of such roads when such relocation is necessary, as determined by the secretary of the army or his designated representative.
