## CHAPTER 137, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 8.05 (1) (a) and 10.16 (3) (d) of the statutes, relating to caucuses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 8.05 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

8.05 (1) (a) When nomination papers are not used, there shall be a caucus to nominate candidates. The governing body shall between January 1 and February 10 decide the date of the caucus during the first week in February. The date of the caucus may be established between the last Tuesday in February and the first Tuesday in March. When possible, preference should be given to having the caucus on the first Tuesday in March. If a primary is held on the day of the caucus, the caucus shall be held after the polls close.

Section 2, 10.16 (3) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

10.16 (3) (d) Prior to February 10. During the first week in February On or before February 10, towns and villages having a caucus shall establish the caucus date between the last Tuesday in February and first Tuesday in March. See s. 8.05 (1) (a).
