## CHAPTER 138, LAWS OF 1969

- AN ACT to repeal 144.76 (1); and to amend 15.347 (1) of the statutes, relating to changing membership of the natural beauty council.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - Section 1. 15.347 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 15.347 (1) There is created in the department of natural resources a natural beauty council. The council shall consist of one senator and 2

assemblymen appointed as are members of standing committees in the respective houses, 4 members representing state agencies and 6 citizens members the department of natural resources, transportation and local affairs and development and the university of Wisconsin extension appointed respectively by the heads of the departments and the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin to serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority; and 6 citizen members appointed by the governor to serve 3-year terms so staggered that 2 citizen posts on the council shall expire each year.

Section 2. 144.76 (1) of the statutes is repealed. Approved August 1, 1969.
