CHAPTER 172, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 66.903 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to inclusion of Minnesota-Wisconsin boundary area commission employes under the Wisconsin retirement fund, group insurance and the public employes social security fund.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.903 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

66.903 (1) (d) Effective on the first day of the first calendar quarter year which commences after the effective date of this paragraph (1969), employes of the Minnesota-Wisconsin boundary area commission are state employes for purposes of ss. 66.90 to 66.918, 66.919 and 66.99, providing such employes, as a result of any agreement approved under s. 14.752, are not eligible to receive similar benefits from any other state covering the same period.
