## CHAPTER 182, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 101.10 (3) of the statutes, relating to eliminating the establishment and maintenance of safety and hygienic museums by the department of industry, labor and human relations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

101.10 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

101.10 (3) To investigate, ascertain, declare and prescribe what safety devices, safeguards or other means or methods of protection are best adapted to render the employes of every employment and place of employment and frequenters of every place of employment safe, and to protect their welfare as required by law or lawful orders, and to establish and maintain museums of safety and hygiene in which shall be exhibited safety devices, safeguards and other means and methods for the protection of life, health, safety and welfare of employes.
