- AN ACT to repeal and recreate 176.08 of the statutes, relating to municipal sales of liquor and beer.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.08 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

176.08 MUNICIPAL STORES PROHIBITED. No city, village or town may engage in the sale of intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages, except as authorized under s. 66.054 (8) (b). This section shall not apply to municipal liquor stores in operation on the effective date of this section. Approved October 30, 1969.
