## CHAPTER 193, LAWS OF 1969

- AN ACT to renumber and amend 49.61 (2) (f); and to create 49.61 (2) (f) 2 and 3 of the statutes, relating to aid to disabled persons.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 49.61 (2) (f) of the statutes is renumbered 49.61 (2) (f) 1 and amended to read:

49.61 (2) (f) 1. Whose property does not exceed a home of reasonable value together with ownership of other property such as each, securities and insurance with a cash surrender value in an amount not to exceed \$1,000 to provide a reasonable reserve for expenses of burial, last sickness and other emergency needs not covered by this section;

SECTION 2. 49.61 (2) (f) 2 and 3 of the statutes are created to read:

49.61 (2) (f) 2. Whose property does not exceed \$750 in cash and liquid assets;

3. Whose property does not exceed an insurance policy with a cash or loan value not to exceed \$1,000.
