CHAPTER 212, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 136.01 (6) (d); and to create 136.01 (6) (f) of the statutes, relating to the definition of real estate broker.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 136.01 (6) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

136.01 (6) (d) Employes of persons enumerated in pars. (a), (b) and, (c) and (f) when engaged in the specific performance of their duties as such employes.

Section 2. 136.01 (6) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

136.01 (6) (f) Any credit union which negotiates loans secured by real estate mortgages or any licensee under ch. 138 which negotiates loans secured by real estate mortgages or any licensed attorney who, incidental to the general practice of law, negotiates or offers or attempts to negotiate a loan, secured or to be secured by mortgage or other transfer of or encumbrance on real estate.
