## CHAPTER 213, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 121.54 (1) of the statutes, relating to transportation for schoolchildren attending a school located outside their city of residence.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

121.54 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

CHAPTER 213 556

121.54 (1) Subsections (2) and (6) and s. 121.57 do not apply to pupils who reside in cities, except that unless the school they attend is located outside the city but within the boundaries of the school district. Where an annual or special meeting of a common school district or a union high school district, or the school board of a city school district or unified school district determines to provide transportation for such pupils, state aid shall be paid in accordance with s. 121.58 and there shall be reasonable uniformity in the transportation furnished such pupils who reside in eities as between pupils attending whether they attend public and or private schools.
