CHAPTER 247, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to appropriate \$11,350 for payment of a claim against the state by Robert Travis for medical expense in connection with an injury to his son, Scott Travis.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund \$11,350 to Robert Travis to compensate him for medical costs incurred as the result of injuries received by his son, Scott Travis, from a fire on a homecoming float at the state university at Platteville on October 30, 1965. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release of the state for any claim on account of such damage.
