CHAPTER 260, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 36.16 (4) of the statutes, relating to athletic scholar-ships at the university of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 36.16 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

36.16 (4) In addition to the remission of resident and nonresident tuition under sub. (1), the university shall as athletic scholarships grant full remission of fees, and resident and nonresident tuition, up to the maximum number of students enrolled on the Madison campus for whom such remission is permitted under Big Ten rules, as recommended by the Madison campus athletic director.

Section 3. INITIAL ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS. (1) On the effective date of this act, the board of regents of the university of Wisconsin shall, on recommendation of the Madison campus athletic director, grant full remission of fees, and resident and nonresident tuition, to not exceeding 70 members each of the freshman, sophomore, junior and senior classes then enrolled at the university of Wisconsin Madison campus. Such initial remissions shall be for the 2nd semester of the 1969-70 academic year. Approved November 25, 1969.
