## CHAPTER 273, LAWS OF 1969

- AN ACT to amend 103.78 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to minors presenting musical entertainment at certain dances.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

103.78 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

103.78 (1) (d) Except as provided in s. 103.69 (3), the employment or appearance shall at no time be in a roadhouse, cabaret, dance hall, night club, tavern or other similar place. This prohibition shall not apply to minors presenting musical entertainment at dances held in any hall on Friday, Saturday or on any other day not followed by a school day or before midnight on Sunday, if the hall was rented for the purpose of celebrating a special event, including but not limited to a wedding, holiday, birthday or anniversary.
