CHAPTER 297, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 100.201 (2) (a) 3 and (h) 1 of the statutes, making the unfair trade practice of selling selected dairy products below cost applicable to all sales except those made to the United States.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

100.201 (2) (a) 3 and (h) 1 of the statutes are amended to read:

100.201 (2) (a) 3. In case of the failure or refusal of any wholesaler to make available or file any record or price list as required by this subsection paragraph, any court of record of competent jurisdiction shall, upon a showing of such failure or refusal, and upon notice, order said wholesaler to give to the retailer or wholesaler so requesting, within a specified time, an inspection thereof, with permission to make a copy therefrom, or to file such information with the department.

(h) 1. Sell or offer to sell, directly or indirectly, any selected dairy product at less than cost with the purpose or intent of injuring, destroying or eliminating competition or a competitor or creating a monopoly, or where the effect may be any of the same. This paragraph shall apply to all sales, including those made to any instrumentality of state or local government and to all religious, charitable or educational organizations or institutions, but does not apply to sales made to the United States.
