CHAPTER 307, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 146.19 (1) (c) of the statutes, relating to the definition of a migrant labor camp site.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

146.19 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read: 146.19 (1) (c) "Migrant labor camp" means the site and all structures maintained as living quarters for 6 or more seasonal or migrant agricultural, industrial or construction workers by any person or for him or under his control and supervision. Where an employer employs a total of 6 or more such workers, each housing location for such workers shall be considered a migrant labor camp.
