CHAPTER 310, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 120.12 (3) (c) of the statutes, granting authority to school boards to lower tax levies voted at annual meetings of the electors in their school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

120.12 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

120.12 (3) (c) If on or before the 3rd Monday in October the school board determines that the annual meeting has voted a tax greater than that needed to operate the schools of the school district for the ensuing school year, the school board may lower the tax voted by the annual meeting. The school district clerk shall certify the appropriate amount so determined to each appropriate municipal clerk who shall assess the amount certified to him and enter it on the tax rolls in lieu of the amount previously reported.
