CHAPTER 369, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 59.245 of the statutes, relating to the law enforcement teletypewriter system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.245 of the statutes is created to read:

59.245 COUNTY TELETYPEWRITERS. By July 1, 1970, every county in the state shall have a teletypewriter installed in a county law enforcement agency which is interconnected with the division of motor vehicles, the crime laboratory and other county, municipal and governmental law enforcement agencies in the teletypewriter communication system. This section shall not preclude the connection and participation in the system of any governmental law enforcement agency and the requirements of this section shall be effective even though there are additions, deletions or modifications in the system.
