CHAPTER 370, LAWS OF 1969

- AN ACT to amend 111.70 (5) of the statutes, relating to labor negotiators in cities.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - 111.70 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 111.70 (5) Any municipal employer may employ a qualified person to discharge the duties of labor negotiator and to represent such municipal employer in conferences and negotiations under this section. In cities of the 1st, 2nd or 3rd class a member any member including the mayor of the city council who resigns therefrom may, during the term for which he is

elected, be eligible to the position of labor negotiator under this subsection, which position during said term has been created by or the selection to which is vested in such city council, and. s. 66.11 (2) shall be deemed inapplicable thereto.
