CHAPTER 380, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 346.41 (3) of the statutes, relating to the display of red or amber reflectors at the entrances to private roads or driveways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

346.41 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

346.41 (3) No person shall, after January 1, 1970, place or maintain, or allow to be displayed any red or amber reflector within the limits of the highway boundaries at or near the entrance to a private road or driveway. The use of blue reflectors is permitted provided there is no disapproval by the highway authority in charge of maintenance of the highway. Approved January 28, 1970.
