CHAPTER 401, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 21.18 (1) of the statutes, relating to command officers of the national guard.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

21.18 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

21.18 (1) The military staff of the governor shall consist of the adjutant general, with a minimum rank of brigadier general; a deputy adjutant general, who may be a general officer; an assistant adjutant general for air, who may be a general officer; a chief surgeon; and not more than 5 aides-de-camp with the rank of colonel; and such other officers as the governor deems necessary. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the governor.
