## CHAPTER 414, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to renumber 60.07 (2); to amend 60.07 (1); and to create 60.07 (2) of the statutes, relating to changing the date of annual town meeting.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 60.07 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

60.07 (1) There Except when changed under sub. (2), there shall be an annual town meeting of each town on the first Tuesday of April at which all business shall be transacted which is by law required or permitted to be transacted at such meeting; no notice of holding any annual town meeting need be given. The hour for holding succeeding annual town meetings may be fix fixed at any such meeting. Any annual or special town meeting may be held in the town or in any village or city within or adjoining the town.

Section 2. 60.07 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 60.07 (3).

Section 3. 60.07 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

60.07 (2) At the annual town meeting, the electors may set the date of the next annual town meeting; however this date shall be within 10 days after the first Tuesday in April and notice shall be given of the meeting under s. 60.13. At any annual town meeting held in April of a year when the office of town chairman is filled by election, the person holding that office on the day prior to the date of the election held to fill said office shall be the presiding officer at the annual town meeting for that year and shall be entitled to receive the same per diem which is regularly paid to such officer. If such person is absent or refuses to serve, the meeting shall be conducted in accordance with s. 60.14.
