CHAPTER 418, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 12.09 (1) of the statutes, relating to financial statements by candidates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

12.09 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

12.09 (1) Every candidate, and the secretary of every personal campaign committee and the secretary of every statutory party committee shall on the Tuesday preceding any primary or election and on the Tuesday following any primary or election, file a financial statement verified upon the oath of such candidate or upon the oath of the secretary of such committee, as the ease may be, which statement shall cover all transactions not accounted for and reported upon in statements theretofore filed. The secretary of every statutory party committee shall, on the Tuesday following any primary or election, file a financial statement verified upon the oath of the secretary, which statement shall cover all transactions not accounted for and reported upon in statements theretofore filed. Each statement after the first shall contain a summary of all preceding state-

ments, and summarize all items theretofore reported under sub. (3). The mailing of such statement within the required time, addressed to the proper filing office, shall be sufficient proof of filing of such statement. Candidates for party committeemen representing each political party shall be exempt from filing a financial statement on the Tuesday preceding any primary or election, but shall file a financial statement on the Tuesday following any primary or election.
