## CHAPTER 438, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 39.03 (1) of the statutes, relating to the abandonment of educational programs at public higher educational institutions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

39.03 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

1415 CHAPTER 439

39.03 (1) The committee coordinating council shall determine what overall educational programs shall be offered in the several units of the university of Wisconsin, the state colleges universities, the collegiate transfer and technical education programs of the schools of vocational, technical and adult education and the county teachers colleges to avoid unnecessary duplication and to utilize to the best advantage the facilities and personnel available for instruction in the fields of higher education. No new educational program shall may be developed or instituted at any institution of higher education except with the committee's coordinating council's approval. No existing educational program for which the legislature has made an appropriation at any institution of higher education shall be abandoned except with legislative approval. The coordinating council may direct the discontinuance of existing educational programs as it deems necessary to conform to state planning efforts and to assure the best utilization of facilities and personnel.
