CHAPTER 441, LAWS OF 1969

- AN ACT to create 22.16 (7m) and 341.04 (intro.) of the statutes, relating to emergency use of vehicles.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 22.16 (7m) of the statutes is created to read:

22.16 (7m) EMERGENCY USE OF VEHICLES. In responding to an official request for help during any state of emergency, any person may operate any vehicle without regard for motor vehicle registration laws and without being subject to arrest under s. 341.04.

SECTION 2. 341.04 (intro.) of the statutes is created to read:

341.04 (intro.) Except during a state of emergency proclaimed under ch. 22:
