CHAPTER 474, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 218.12 of the statutes, relating to standards for construction and design of mobile homes manufactured or sold in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

218.12 of the statutes is created to read:

218.12 MOBILE HOME DEALERS AND MANUFACTURERS; DE-SIGNS AND CONSTRUCTION OF MOBILE HOMES. No person who engages in the business of manufacturing or selling mobile homes in this state shall manufacture or sell a mobile home which does not conform to the standard for mobile homes developed by the United States of America standards institute in book A 119.1. This section is not applicable to any standard which is modified by a department rule promulgated under ch. 227, by the department of health and social services or by the department of transportation.
