CHAPTER 475, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 59.965 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to appointment of one member of the expressway and transportation commissions in populous counties by the county executive.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 59.965 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.965 (2) (a) In any county having a population of 500,000 or more, there is created a county expressway and transportation commission which shall function as a part of the county government. Such commission shall consist of 5 4 members to be appointed by the governor and one member by the county executive. The first appointees shall serve for terms of 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 years, respectively. Thereafter each member shall be appointed for terms of 5 years each and until their successors are appointed and qualified. All appointees shall be and remain residents of such county and one appointee shall be a county board member appointed by the county executive. Appointments to fill vacancies and for terms after the initial term shall be made in the same manner as provided in

this paragraph. Certification of such appointments shall be filed with the county clerk.

Section 2. On the effective date of this act, the first term of a present member of the county expressway and transportation commission which expires shall be filled by an appointee of the county executive. Approved February 23, 1970.
