CHAPTER 479, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 15.08 (1) of the statutes, relating to requiring senate approval of examining board members.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

15.08 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.08 (1) All members of examining boards shall be residents of this state and shall, unless otherwise provided by law, be appointed nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed. Appointments shall be for the terms provided by law. Terms shall expire on July 1 and shall, if the term is for an even number of years, expire in an odd-numbered year. If a vacancy is required to be filled by an appointee who is a member of a private organization, that organization may make recommendations to the appointing authority for filling the vacancy.
