CHAPTER 51, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to grant to Milwaukee county Lake Michigan submerged lands therein described, for park, recreational and marina and other related purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is hereby granted and ceded to Milwaukee county, to be used for park, recreational and marina and other related purposes, all the right, title and interest of this state in the submerged land lying along and adjacent to the shore of Lake Michigan, constituting the bed of said Lake on the eastern frontage of the City of Milwaukee, being a part of Section 22, Township 7 North, Range 22 East, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the west ¼ corner of section 22, township 7 north, range 22 east, (assuming the west line of the northwest ¼ of said section 22 as bearing north), running thence north 89° 30' 05" east 1407.82 feet to a point in the center of the United States Breakwater,

being the point of beginning of the land herein to be described and also known as point "A" in this description; thence south 25° 53' 15" east along the center of said United States Breakwater 2067.61 feet to a point to be known as point "B" in this description; thence south 17° 17' 45" east along said United States Breakwater 80.63 feet to a point: thence south 0° 05' 45" east along said United States Breakwater 73.90 feet to a point; thence north 64° 06' 45" east to a point in a line which is located 1500 feet northeasterly of and parallel with a line extending from point "A" to point "B" as described above and the extension thereof; thence north 25° 53' 15" west on a line located 1500 feet northeasterly of and parallel with said line extending from point "A" to point "B" described above and the extension thereof to the westerly shore line of Lake Michigan; thence southwesterly along said westerly shore line of Lake Michigan and the extension thereof to the center of said United States Breakwater; thence along the center of said United States Breakwater to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom those submerged lands lying westerly of the easterly limits of the submerged land grant according to Chapter 261 of the 1933 Laws of the State of Wisconsin, being Number 741A as published on June 16, 1933, and also excepting those submerged lands lying westerly of the easterly limits of the submerged land grant according to Chapter 389 of the 1915 Laws of the State of Wisconsin, being No. 400S as published on July 13, 1915.
