CHAPTER 6, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to create 213.10 (7) of the statutes, relating to membership in firemen's relief associations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

213.10 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

213.10 (7) For purposes of this section, "members of the paid fire department" means all fire department personnel who are engaged in the duties of fire fighting, fire fighting training and directly related skills, including fire prevention, investigation and inspection. All other members of such department shall have the option of joining such association upon commencement of their employment with such department; and such employes, together with others who are transferred to or are, on the date of this subsection (1969), performing duties other than fire fighting, fire fighting training and directly related skills, including fire prevention, investigation and inspection, shall have the option of continuing their membership in such association.
