CHAPTER 62, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 121.53 (2) (b) and 121.54 (7) (a) 3 of the statutes, relating to authorizing the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped to provide transportation to activities more than 50 miles beyond the state line.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 121.53 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

121.53 (2) (b) In connection with any extracurricular school activity authorized by and made in compliance with s. 121.54 (7). When so used, such insurance shall apply only to accidents occurring in this state and not exceeding 50 miles beyond its boundaries, but the Wisconsin school for the deaf and the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped may procure insurance without regard to this mileage limitation.

Section 2. 121.54 (7) (a) 3 of the statutes is amended to read:

121.54 (7) (a) 3. Such use does not extend more than 50 miles beyond the boundary of this state, but this restriction does not apply to any such use by the Wisconsin school for the deaf or by the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped; and
