CHAPTER 97, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 176.05 (9m) (a) of the statutes, relating to the restrictions on the issuance of liquor licenses near schools, churches and hospitals.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.05 (9m) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

176.05 (9m) (a) No retail "Class A" or "Class B" license shall be issued for premises the main entrance of which is less than 300 feet from the main entrance of any established public school, parochial school, hospital or church. Such distance shall be measured via by the shortest route along the highway from the closest point of the boundary main entrance of such school, church or hospital to the elesent main entrance to such premises.
