

**CHAPTER 98, LAWS OF 1969**

AN ACT to renumber and amend 43.36 (1); and to create 43.36 (1) (b) of the statutes, relating to increasing membership of the board of trustees of public libraries in cities of the 1st class.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 43.36 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 43.36 (1) (a) and amended to read:

43.36 (1) (a) Each ~~such institution~~ *public museum under s. 43.35* shall be administered by a separate board of 9 trustees, consisting of the president of the school board and the city superintendent of schools as ex officio members, and 7 additional appointive members who shall be appointed by the mayor on the 3rd Tuesday in April. Three of said appointive members shall be selected from among the aldermen holding a 4-year term, and shall serve as such trustees during their aldermanic terms. The other 4 shall be selected from among the residents and taxpayers of the city, for original terms of 1, 2, 3 and 4 years, respectively, from the first day of May next after their appointment, and for successive terms of 4 years each.

SECTION 2. 43.36 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

43.36 (1) (b) The board administering each public library under s. 43.35 shall consist of 9 trustees chosen in accordance with par. (a) and a 10th trustee to be a taxpayer residing in the county outside the city of the 1st class. The latter shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the county board for a 4-year term commencing on May 1 next after such appointment, and for successive terms of 4 years each.
