CHAPTER 99, LAWS OF 1969

AN ACT to amend 86.31 (1) (c) of the statutes, permitting the state highway commission to reclassify cities for highway aids when population has increased or decreased.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

86.31 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

86.31 (1) (c) Whenever it ~~shall be made to appear~~ *appears* to the satisfaction of the commission that, since the taking of the last federal census, any city ~~by the annexation of adjacent territory~~ has *increased or decreased* its population beyond ~~or below~~ 10,000, 35,000, or 150,000, ~~then~~ the payments to be made to such city pursuant to ~~the provisions of~~ this subsection shall be made on the same basis as if such *increased or decreased* population had appeared from the last federal census
