CHAPTER 102, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to temporarily waive certain requirements for foreign physicians to practice in Wisconsin for Dr. Bishnu Prasad Choudhuri.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

CHAPTER 102 130

Notwithstanding the requirements for immigrant physicians under section 448.03 (1) of the statutes relating to holding an immigrant visa, and the requirements of section 448.03 (2) relating to approved residency and internship, the legislature hereby authorizes the medical examining board to issue temporary licenses to practice medicine and surgery to Dr. Bishnu Prasad Choudhuri of India, until the end of March, 1972, for the purpose of practicing medicine and surgery in Menomonie, Dunn county, Wisconsin, as an associate in the Red Cedar Clinic S.C. of that city.
