CHAPTER 238, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to create 100.201 (8m) of the statutes, relating to trade practices in the dairy industry.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

100.201 (8m) of the statutes is created to read:

100.201 (8m) JURISDICTION. This section shall apply to transactions, acts or omissions which take place in whole or in part outside this state. In any action or administrative proceeding the department has jurisdiction of the person served under s. 262.06 when any act or omission outside this state by the defendant or respondent results in local injury or may have the effect of injur-

ing competition or a competitor in this state or unfairly diverts trade or business from a competitor, if at the time:

- (a) Solicitation or service activities were carried on within this state by or on behalf of the defendant or respondent; or
- (b) Selected dairy products processed, serviced, distributed or manufactured by the defendant or respondent were received for resale in this state at retail or wholesale without regard to where sale or delivery takes place.
