## **CHAPTER 250, Laws of 1971**

AN ACT to amend 341.26 (3) (d) of the statutes, relating to removing the gross weight limit on registration of vehicles used for transportation of certain dairy products.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

341.26 (3) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

341.26 (3) (d) For each motor vehicle used exclusively in the transportation of cheese, butter and powdered milk when such cheese,

butter and powdered milk are transported from plant to plant or to warehouses within this state and are transported by vehicles registered at a gross weight of not more than 20,000 pounds, a fee to be determined in accordance with par. (g) on the basis of maximum gross weight.
