CHAPTER 281, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to create 343.32 (5) of the statutes, relating to point system reductions for drivers who take traffic safety courses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

343.32 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

343.32 (5) In adopting rules for weighing traffic convictions by their seriousness under sub. (2), the administrator also may provide by rule for a reduction of points if a person shows to the division satisfactory evidence of completion of a course of instruction in traffic safety, defensive driving or similar course or driver improvement counseling approved by the administrator.
