CHAPTER 30, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to temporarily waive certain requirements for foreign physicians to practice in Wisconsin for Dr. Ronald Suss.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Notwithstanding the requirements for immigrant physicians under section 448.03 (1) of the statutes relating to holding an immigrant visa, and the requirements of section 448.03 (2) relating to approved residency and internship, the legislature hereby authorizes the medical examining board to issue temporary licenses to practice medicine and surgery to Dr. Ronald Suss of Melbourne, Australia, for the purpose of establishing a medical practice in Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin.
