CHAPTER 335, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to create 13.565 of the statutes, relating to legislative approval of rules relating to animal waste treatment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. <u>LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this act is to permit careful review, prior to their implementation, of any administrative proposals in an area having the potential for serious economic impact on the state's farmers.

SECTION 2. 13.565 of the statutes is created to read:

13.565 LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF CERTAIN RULES. Prior to the establishment of any rules relating to animal waste treatment, the state agency proposing the rules shall submit the rules to the senate and assembly committees on agriculture. A public hearing shall be held before the committees to review the proposed rules. The rules shall enter into effect only upon approval as a joint resolution by each house of the legislature.
