CHAPTER 57, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 292.01 (2) of the statutes, relating to the right of habeas corpus for inmates of central state hospital.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

292.01 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

292.01 (2) All persons confined in any hospital or asylum institution as insane, except persons confined in the central state hospital for the insane mentally ill may prosecute such writ, and the question of insanity mental illness shall be determined by the court or judge issuing the same; and if such court or judge shall decide decides that the person is insane mentally ill such decision shall be no not bar to the prosecution of such writ a second time if it shall be is claimed that such person has been restored to reason.
