CHAPTER 58, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to appropriate \$6,403.15 from the general fund for payment of a claim by Dane county against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

CHAPTER 58

There is appropriated from the general fund \$6,403.15 to Dane county as reimbursement for costs incurred on February 12, 1970, in providing extraordinary police services for the preservation of order and protection of state property in the vicinity of the Madison campus of the university of Wisconsin. These services were requested by university officials to quell disturbances during placement interviews by General Electric Corporation. Acceptance of this payment shall operate as a full and complete release to the state for any claim on account of such services rendered to the state.
