CHAPTER 68, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to amend 59.04 (1) (a) and (b); and to create 59.04 (3) of the statutes, relating to meeting places for county boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.04 (1) (a) and (b) of the statutes are amended to read:

- 59.04 (1) (a) Every board shall hold an annual meeting on the Tuesday after the second 2nd Monday of November in each year at the county seat for the purpose of transacting business. When that day falls on November 11 the annual meeting shall be held the next succeeding day. Any board may by its rules establish an earlier date during October or November for such annual meeting and may by rule establish regular meeting dates throughout the year at which to transact general business.
- (b) The annual meeting may be adjourned by the clerk, upon the written request of a majority of the supervisors, to a day designated in the request, but not less than one week nor more than 3 weeks from the Tuesday after the second 2nd Monday of November. Upon such adjournment being made, the clerk shall give each supervisor written notice of the time and place to which the annual meeting has been adjourned.

SECTION 2. 59.04 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

59.04 (3) All meetings shall be held in the county at places designated by the board. The board shall give adequate public notice of the time, place and purpose of each meeting.
