CHAPTER 81, Laws of 1971

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 50.06 (6) (b); and to create 50.06 (6) (c) of the statutes, relating to state aid for outpatient dispensaries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 50.06 (6) (b) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

50.06 (6) (b) The state reimbursement for each patient visit shall amount to two-sevenths of the state credit as established in s. 50.04 (7) (a) for outpatient visits eligible for state aid. If an X-ray is taken by the sanatorium an additional two-sevenths of the state credit under s. 50.04 (7) (a) shall be reimbursed to the county. Any 14 x 17 X-ray taken outside a sanatorium on positive reactors to the mantoux skin test shall qualify for state aid in the same manner as additional reimbursement for X-rays taken inside a sanatorium.

SECTION 2. 50.06 (6) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

50.06 (6) (e) Any fees collected from patients may be kept by the outpatient dispensary to provide services outside the dispensary

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in preventive and case-finding programs with groups at risk and needing preventive measures.
