CHAPTER 135, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to repeal 103.44; and to amend 146.03 (4) of the statutes, relating to permits for house contract work.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 103.44 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. 146.03 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

146.03 (4) Every manufacturer giving out articles or materials to be manufactured, in any home shall issue therewith a label bearing the name or place of business of the factory, written or printed legibly in English, and shall keep a register of the names and addresses of the persons to whom given, and with whom contracts to do so were made, the quantities given out and completed and the wages paid. This register may be inspected by the department, a district health officer, or the local health officer, or a deputy of the department of industry, labor and human relations.
