## CHAPTER 222, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 6.55 (2) (a) and (3) of the statutes, relating to affidavits by registered voters on a late voter registration card for an elector.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6.55(2)(a) and (3) of the statutes are amended to read:

6.55 (2) (a) Any qualified elector in the ward where he desires to vote who has not previously filed a registration card or whose name does not appear on the registry list shall be entitled to vote at the election if he delivers to the municipal clerk a properly executed registration card with an affidavit sworn to by him, or if he cannot obtain a registration card, he shall list all the information required on the registration card. The registration card or the listing of required information shall be substantiated by the affidavit of 2 freeholders registered voters, electors in the ward or aldermanic district, corroborating all the material statements therein. The signing of the affidavits by the freeholders registered voters and the elector's signature shall be done in the presence of the municipal clerk not later than 5 p.m. of the day before an election. All affidavits shall be sworn to before an officer authorized to administer oaths. Underscored, stricken, and vetoed text may not be searchable. If you do not see text of the Act, SCROLL DOWN.

## CHAPTER 222

(3) No compensation shall be paid or received for taking or certifying any affidavit, under sub. (2). A freeholder registered voter may not corroborate more than 5 elector affidavits at any one election.
