## CHAPTER 225, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 6.28 (2) of the statutes, relating to initial registration of voters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6.28 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

6.28 (2) At the first <u>general</u> election held after registration is required or adopted, any qualified elector may register at the polls the day of the election and vote in the election being conducted. Registration shall be by the regular election officials, or, in the discretion of the municipal governing body, by a special registration deputy appointed by the municipal clerk for each ward.
