CHAPTER 228, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 345.26 (3) (b) of the statutes, relating to receipts for bail deposits in traffic cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

345.26 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

345.26 (3) (b) The person receiving the deposit shall prepare a receipt in triplicate on a serially numbered form, showing the purpose for which the deposit is made and stating that the alleged violator may inquire at the office of the clerk of court or justice regarding the disposition of the deposit, and shall deliver the original to the alleged violator or, if the deposit is made by mail, shall mail the receipt by return mail if requested. The receipt referred to in this subsection may be included as part of the uniform citation under s. 345.25.
