## CHAPTER 234, Laws of 1973

AN ACT to amend 257.37 of the statutes, relating to chairman of the county board of judges in populous counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

257.37 of the statutes is amended to read:

257.37 County board of judges in populous counties. In counties having a population of 200,000 or more there is constituted a county board of judges to consist of all the judges of courts of record in such county. A circuit judge or county judge shall be chairman of such board. Such board shall have power may by majority vote of all members to organize and to establish, modify and repeal rules, not inconsistent with the statutes, to provide for the orderly, efficient and expeditious handling of all matters within the jurisdiction of such courts.
