## CHAPTER 26, Laws of 1973

- AN ACT to create 20.855 (6) of the statutes, making an appropriation for Wisconsin participation in the Marquette-Joliet tercentennial commemoration.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
- SECTION 1. At the appropriate place in the schedule under section 20.005 (2) of the statutes, insert the following amounts for the purpose indicated:

20.855 Miscellaneous appropriations
(6) MARQUETTE-JOLIET TERCENTENNIAL
(a) State subsidy GPR C 10,000 -0-

SECTION 2. 20.855 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

- 20.855 (6) MARQUETTE-JOLIET TERCENTENNIAL. For the commemoration of the tercentennial of Marquette-Joliet exploration, but any unencumbered balances under pars. (g) and (m) on June 30, 1976, shall be transferred to the appropriations under s. 20.245 (1) (g) and (m):
- (a) State subsidy. As a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule to subsidize appropriate commemorative activities. Any unencumbered balance in this appropriation on June 30, 1976, shall revert to the general fund.
- (g) Gifts and grants. All moneys received from gifts and grants to carry out the purposes for which they were received.
- (m) Federal grants. All moneys received from the federal government for the purposes for which made and received.
